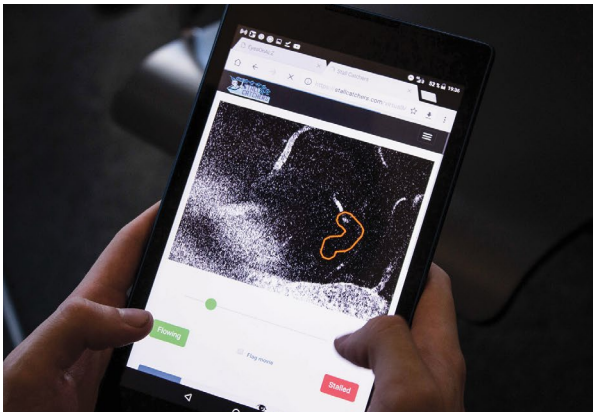
Flu Near You

Stall Catchers

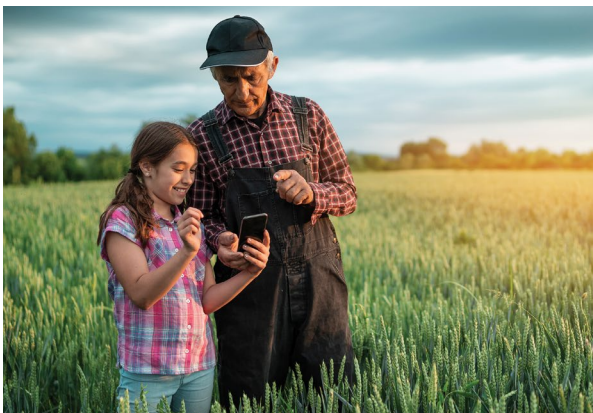
Play an online game that can help speed up Alzheimer's research.
